




# Forward Facing Convertible Seat

- Ideally outgrown the rear facing height OR weight limit of their seat
- Child dressed in thin layers of clothing
- Bum in the crease of the seat, crotch buckle in slot closest to child
- Shoulder straps entering the shell of the seat at or above the level of the child's shoulders.
- Lower straps coming over hips and connecting in the middle
- Chest clip positioned at the level of the armpits, over the chest
- Straps laying flat against the child's body, not able to pinch and hold a loop of strap at the shoulder
- Installed with the UAS or seatbelt through the correct (forward facing) belt path
- Top tether securely anchored to the vehicle's designated anchor point
