



Rear Facing Convertible Seat

● Head at least one inch below the top of the seat

● Bum in the crease of the seat, crotch buckle in slot closest to child

● Shoulder straps arching over shoulder, entering the shell of the seat at or below the level of the child's shoulders.


● Lower straps coming over hips and connecting in the middle

● Chest clip positioned at the level of the armpits, over the chest

● Straps laying flat against the child's body, not able to pinch and hold a loop of strap at the shoulder

● Installed with the UAS or seatbelt through the correct (rear facing) belt path

● Installed at the correct angle in the vehicle (follow leveling guide on seat)
